ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

Skopos Design is a manufacturer totally committed to reducing its impact on the global environment throughout all operational activities. The Management Team at Skopos Design has developed a strategy that encompasses all elements of business activities and involves our employees to enable our environmental impact to be minimized. We have held a Climate Change Agreement since 2006, and improvements in our carbon emissions are targeted and assessed through our Textile Trade Association. We were awarded the Carbon Trust Standard* in 2010, recognition of our work to date and a standard to continue to strive for. We were also awarded the Green Business Award for 2010 for Dewsbury, presented by the Green Business Network Kirklees Council.

*The Carbon Trust Standard was launched in June 2008. It builds on other existing international Standards for the measurement of corporate carbon emissions:

- Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Standard from the World Resources Institute (WRI) and the World Business Council for Sustainable Development (WBCSD).
- ISO14064-1 :2006, which provides a specification (at the organization level) for quantification and reporting of greenhouse gas emissions and removals.

Skopos Design commits to:

- Facilitate all departments to be able to set targets, measure and benchmark our performance and work towards ongoing improvement by:
 - Continual investigation and implementation of energy usage reduction and the associated lowering of our carbon footprint.
 - Minimising manufacturing waste with objectives set to reduce printed, dyed and finished product waste.
 - Reduction of water usage and effluent production
 - Reduction of landfill waste (plastic, cloth and cardboard)
 - Use more environmentally friendly materials/methods wherever feasible
- Engage with our supply chain, ensuring they are able to support our efforts in our mission to reduce our environmental impact.
- Provide staff with training and resources required to achieve continuous environmental improvements. By educating and encouraging staff, Skopos endeavor to have the whole company participating in our environmental commitment and enabling environmental challenges to be met through process improvements.
- Offer our customers products and services in line with their specific environmental strategies.
- Meet and exceed environmental legislation by setting and beating objectives and targets.
- Communicate our environmental achievements to our staff, stakeholders , suppliers and customers.
- Review our Environmental Policy on an annual basis - next review due April 2012.
